Notes On Applications for Secondary 1 Places in 2022/23

We warmly welcome you to HKMA David Li Kwok Po College. As the College is not participating in the Government's Central Allocation System, we welcome applications from all Primary 6 students. Please note that the College is a co-educational school operating under the Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) and uses English as the medium of instruction.

1. Application Periods:

Completed application should be submitted by the following dates:

Stage 1:	4 November to 24 December, 2021	Enrolment Quota: 140 places
Stage 2:	26 July to 27 July, 2022	Enrolment Quota: 24 places

2. Submission of Applications:

(For Stage 1)

- Applicants should complete the online application form via our College's website: http://www.hkmadavidli.edu.hk/admission/s1 admission/.
- Applicants will receive a reference number and will be informed of the deadline for submitting the required documents to our General Office after submitting the online application.
- Applicants should <u>print out the completed application form</u> and submit it, together with the required documents and application fee (\$50 in cash), to our General Office <u>in person</u> before the deadline. Failure to submit all the required documents and fee by the deadline would result in rejection of the application. (Office hours of School Office: Mon-Fri: 9:00 am − 5:00 pm; Sat: 9:00 am − 12:00 nn; closed on Sundays and Public Holidays).
- Copies of the following documents from the student applicant have to be submitted:
 - HKID Card / Passport
 - Primary 6 Student Record Form
 - Academic report cards for the past 3 years

- · Relevant certificates, awards and or proof of extra-curricular activities, if any
- Proof of residential address in English (within the past 3 months), e.g. an electricity bill
- Please note that once submitted, the application form, application fee and other documents cannot be retrieved.

(For Stage 2)

- Applicants should complete the online application form via our College's website: http://www.hkmadavidli.edu.hk/admission/s1_admission/, or at the College. Applicants will then receive a reference number.
- Applicants should submit the printout of the completed application form, together with the required documents and application fee (\$50 in cash), to the College in person.
- Copies of the following documents from the student applicant have to be submitted:
 - HKID Card / Passport
 - Academic report cards for the past 3 years
 - · Relevant certificates, awards and lor proof of extra-curricular activities, if any
 - Admission Slip
 - Proof of residential address in English (within the past 3 months), e.g. an electricity bill
- Please note that once submitted, the application form, application fee and other documents cannot be retrieved.
- 3. Taking Chinese Language as a Second Language (Cantonese as the medium of instruction):

'Chinese as a Second Language' is offered as a five-year course at our College for non-Chinese speakers. By the end of the third year, students will be asked to sit for the General Certificate of Secondary Education (Chinese) Examination. If they secure a Grade C or above in the examination, they will be regarded as having obtained an alternative Chinese qualification as part of the University Entrance Requirements (UER) in Hong Kong. When students progress to the final year, they will attend the General Certificate of Education A Level (Chinese) Examination to obtain a higher level of qualification in Chinese Language.

4. Selection Details:

All student applicants will be granted an interview in Stage 1 admission. However, In Stage 2 admission, only those shortlisted student applicants will be invited for an interview. Shortlisting will be done on the basis of students' academic and non-academic achievements.

The interview process will comprise two parts:

- 1 > Student interview, to be conducted in English, Cantonese and Putonghua (non-Chinese speakers will only be interviewed in English)
- 2 > Family interview, to be conducted in either English or Cantonese

Student applicants will attend a group interview to assess their English, Cantonese and Putonghua proficiency, as well as their understanding of society and the world in general. During the family interview, a range of questions will be asked to determine whether the student applicants and their families have a good understanding of the mission of the College.

The College's assessment criteria for S1 admission and the relevant weightings are as follows:

Assessment Aspect	Weighting
Academic results, conduct and comments from teachers	50%
2. ECA / Community service and other non-academic achievements	25%
3. Admission interview	25%

Parents of successful student applicants will be asked, in accordance with Education Bureau's policy, to sign an undertaking with the College stating that, in acceptance of our offer, they agree to give up any other subsidized S1 places. They will also be required to surrender their child's Primary 6 Student Record Form to the College.

6. School Fees:

The College's school fees are currently under review and there may be adjustment to the fees for the 2022/23 school year, pending approval from both the College's Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) and the Education Bureau.

The College's IMC has stated that school fee increase for existing students for the remaining school years will not exceed 7% per annum.

To ensure that students will not be deprived of the chance to study at our College solely because of financial difficulties, the College offers a financial assistance scheme to help needy students, including those receiving Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or assistance from the Student Financial Assistance Agency. Eligible applicants will be granted either full or half-level school fee reduction.

7. S1 Entrance Scholarship:

To reward outstanding all-rounded students, two scholarships will be offered to S1 entrants for 2022/23 school year. Each scholarship holder will be granted a six-year full school fee subsidy. Continuation of scholarship is subject to the students' satisfactory academic performance during his/her period of study. The College will take into consideration students' academic and discipline reports from primary schools, as well as their performance in extra-curricular activities. Eligible applicants will be nominated to apply for the scholarship and informed by the College in due course.

8. Protocol:

2022/23 學年中一入學申請須知

香港管理專業協會李國寶中學是一所直接資助計劃(直資)男女校,以英語作為主要教學語言。 本校不參加政府統一派位,所有小六學生均可透過以下程序向本校申請中一學位:

1. 報名日期:

申請人須於下列限期內遞交填妥之申請表格:

第一階段:	2021年11月4日至12月24日(錄取名額:140個)
第二階段:	2022年7月26日至7月27日 (錄取名額:24個)

2. 遞交申請表方法:

(第一階段)

- 申請人在遞交網上申請表格後將獲發一個參考編號,並得知親身遞交所有所需文件到本校校務處的截止日期。
- 申請人須<u>列印已填妥之入學申請表格</u>,連同所需文件及入學申請費用(現金港幣 50元)於截止日期前<u>親身遞交</u>到本校校務處,否則該申請將會被取消。(校務處開放時間:星期一至五上午 9 時至下午 5 時;星期六上午 9 時至中午 12 時;星期日及公眾假期休息)
- 所需遞交文件為學生申請人的下列各項文件影印本:
 - 香港身份證/護照
 - 小六學生資料表
 - · 過去三年成績表
 - 證書、獎狀及/或參與課外活動的證明(如有)

- · 英文住址證明(最近三個月內),如電費單
- 申請表、報名費及文件一經遞交,概不退還。

(第二階段)

- 申請人可透過本校網頁 (http://www.hkmadavidli.edu.hk/admission/s1_admission/) 或 親身到校填寫網上申請表格,並在遞交網上申請表格後獲發一個參考編號。
- 申請人須把已填妥之入學申請表格(列印本),連同所需文件及入學申請費用(現金港幣50元),親身交回本校。
- 所需遞交文件為學生申請人的下列各項文件影印本:
 - 香港身份證/護照
 - · 過去三年成績表
 - 證書、獎狀及/或參與課外活動的證明(如有)
 - 入學註冊證
 - 英文住址證明(最近三個月內),如電費單
- 申請表、報名費及文件一經遞交,概不退還。

3. 修讀「中文作為第二語言」(廣東話授課):

本校專為非華語學生而設的「中文作為第二語言」課程為期五年。學生於課程的第三年應考 英國普通中學教育文憑(中文)考試,如考獲 C 級或以上,便符合香港各大學對非華語學生 的中國語文入學要求。學生會於課程最後一年應考英國普通教育高級程度證書(中文)考試, 以獲取更高資歷。

4. 甄撰程序:

所有第一階段的學生申請人均會獲得面試機會。於第二階段,則只有通過遴選的學生申請人獲安排面試。遴選時本校會考慮學生的學業成績及其他範疇的表現。

面試分為下列兩部分:

- 1>以英語、廣東話及普通話進行的學生面試(非華語學生的面試以英語進行)
- 2 > 以英語或廣東話進行的家長會面

小組面試主要測試學生申請人的英語、廣東話及普通話能力,以及他們對社會及世界的認知。此外,學校會透過與家長面談了解家長及學生申請人對本校的認識。

本校收生評估所涵蓋的範疇及相關比重如下:

按教育局規定,獲取錄學生申請人的家長須簽署一份承諾書,表明同意接受本校的中一學位,並願意放棄其他政府資助中一學位;家長亦須將學生申請人的小六學生資料表呈交本校。

6. 學費:

本校現正進行學費檢討, 2022/23 學年的學費或會有所調整, 有關決定有待本校法團校董會及教育局審批。

按本校法團校董會的指示,學生入讀本校後,於在學期間,每年學費的增幅不高於7%。

為確保學生不會因無法繳付學費而不能在本校就讀,我們將透過學費資助計劃,為有經濟困難的學生提供資助(包括正領取綜合社會保障援助或學資處財政資助之學生)。合資格的申請人可獲全額或半額學費減免。

7. 中一新生獎學金:

為獎勵在學業及其他範疇有傑出表現的學生,本校設有兩個獎學金頒予新入學的中一學生。得 獎者將獲六年全額學費資助;學生在學期間必須保持學業成績優良,才可繼續獲發獎學金。學 生將獲校方遴選推薦參加,本校在甄選時會考慮學生在小學之校內學業和操行成績,以及課外 活動表現,合資格之申請者將獲另行通知。

8. 公平原則:
